Bargoed Terrace, Ponthenri – Phases 1 and 2 - £62,000  
Horeb Road, Five Roads - £22,000  
Old Wyevale site, Bynea - £53,000

A request was made therefore, for this Council to draw up recreational schemes for the County Council's approval.

**290. HEOL LLANELLI, PONTYATES –  
PROVISION OF PARKING RESTRICTIONS**

During discussion, Members enquired as to whether the proprietor and local residents had been consulted as a decision had to be mindful of the business' needs. Should matters not be resolved satisfactorily, then Cllr. Rees could raise the issue again at a future meeting of the Committee.
