294. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

295. MEMBERS' DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

296. BT PUBLIC PAYPHONES

Members considered correspondence received from the Planning Division, Carmarthenshire County Council informing it had been asked to initiate a consultation exercise regarding BT's proposal for removing public payphones as well as giving communities the opportunity to 'adopt' red telephone kiosks within Carmarthenshire at a cost of £1 each and to remove the telephony service at each of these kiosks.

Following discussion, whereby Members enquired about the implications of maintaining a red telephone kiosk, it was

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297. COMMUNITY RESILIENCE CARMARTHENSHIRE


Following a lengthy discussion, it was
