OBJECTION unless

1. The Council's concerns over the potential loss of important amenity/green space and local flooding and drainage matters were addressed. The location was prone to flooding and Members felt the development would increase the risk of localised flooding to neighbouring estates due to surface water run off combined with the limited capacity of the existing sewerage infrastructure. Effective controls needed to be put in place to remedy local concerns.

2. Ground conditions were also an issue. Site history suggested there were issues with the type of fill material in the sub soil which resulted in the floors of neighbouring properties having to be excavated and replaced. Soil sampling and testing should be conducted as part of the planning application process.

3. Furthermore, the Council was aware that the parcel of land was previously re-landscaped as part of an environmental community project which was subject to grant funding support. Footpaths and seating were created and a number of plants and shrubs planted in addition to trees and the placement of the metal sculptures. The Council wished to safeguard as far as possible the benefits of that community project with the landscaping features created being retained or transferred to another green site possibly in the immediate vicinity or failing that to an alternative location in the Pemberton Ward, and that this also be a requirement if planning permission was granted.

4. The recommendations contained in the supporting Ecology report must be actioned in full as part of any planning permission granted.

5. Safer routes in the community for school children was also an issue which needed to be addressed.

306. TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE OF HEOL HOREB FIVE ROADS, LLANELLI

Correspondence was received from the Acting Head of Transport and Engineering, Carmarthenshire County Council, stating a request had been received for the temporary road closure of Heol Horeb, Five Roads, for a point of 660 metres north of its junction with the B4309 Road for a distance of 333 metres in a north easterly direction.

The closure was required for Welsh Water to undertake work on 7 December, 2011, for a period of three days with an alternative route in place.
