FELINFOEL



Felinfoel is one of the smaller wards in the Rural area with a population of 2,095. It has a younger than average population and faces significant challenges in terms of health, education and employment deprivation. The Communities First programme is active in the area and works with key agencies to provide help and support on a targeted basis to local people. The area is used as a resource by surrounding communities centred on an excellent recreation field and community resource centre, owned by the Rural Council. The Felinfoel Partnership brings together local groups to help improve prospects for the area. The area is home to two of Llanelli's largest manufacturing employers.

The quality of the local environment and the volume of local traffic were two key issues that emerged from the community survey in Felinfoel.

The local history offer is strong with one of the oldest breweries in the UK bearing the village name and the historic mill site attracting passing visitors.
