337. PROPOSED '40 MPH SPEED LIMIT' - B4308 CWMBACH ROAD, LLANELLI - STATUTORY CONSULTATION

Correspondence was received from the Technical Services Department, Carmarthenshire County Council. It was proposed to extend the existing 30mph limit and impose a 40mph speed limit on the B4308 Cwmbach Road within the limits specified below. The proposed 40mph speed limit and extension of the existing 30mph limit were considered necessary in the interest of road safety.

Side Road to Sandy Road, Pwll (C2124)	40mph	From its junction with the B4308, for a distance of 40 metres in a southerly direction.
Side Road to Pwll Road, Pwll (C22207)	40mph	From junction with B4308, for a distance of 53 metres in a south easterly direction.
Side Road to Burry Port (U2322)	40mph	From junction with B4308, for a distance of 221 metres in a southerly direction.
Cwmbach Road B4308)	30mph	From a point 130m west of the centre line of junction with Denham Avenue, for a distance of 150 metres in a north westerly direction towards Cwmbach,

RESOLVED that the proposal be supported in the interest of highway safety.
