### INDEPENDENT REMUNERATION PANEL 349. FOR WALES – FINAL ANNUAL REPORT FOR 2012/13

Members received correspondence from the Chairman, Independent Remuneration Panel for Wales, stating the Panel's Annual Report dated December 2011, which sets the payment to elected members for the financial year 2012/13 had now been published (excerpts of which had been previously circulated to Members).

Members attention was drawn to section 6 of the report which stated therein that it would require a considerable investment of time and effort on the Panel's part to devise a remuneration framework which could be seen to be both fair and equitable, and which would give proper regard to the number and variety of community and town councils in Wales. Therefore the Panel intended to undertake evidence gathering next year which was likely to require written submissions from community and town councils and might include visits to a broadly representative selection of councils.

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The Panel anticipated that proposals for a national remuneration framework for community and town councils in Wales would be ready for consultation in summer 2012 and for implementation in 2013/2014. Until then allowances for members of community and town councils would continue to be payable under the Local Authorities (Allowances for Members of Community Council)(Wales) Regulations 2003.

Members received correspondence from the Chief Executive, Carmarthenshire County Council enclosing a copy letter from the Field Change Advisor, Post Office Ltd.
