517. TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT (1990) (AS AMENDED) APPEAL APP 1055/S/27210 35 GELLI ROAD, LLANELLI

Further to Minute No. 226 (S/27210) Members considered correspondence received from the Head of Planning, Carmarthenshire County Council, stating that an appeal had been lodged with the National Assembly for Wales against the refusal of planning permission. The writer stated the appeal was proceeding under the Householder Appeal Services pilot currently being run by the Planning Inspectorate.

Under the pilot, the Inspectorate only encouraged consultees such as the Council to comment on the appeal if evidence came to light or there had been a change in circumstance since the original comments were submitted.
