

Pwll Community Centre update.

Following further discussions with Darren Rees, Community Development Officer for Llanelli Rural Council he has confirmed Structural, Electrical, Heating and Water surveys will be needed and assessed prior to any interest being lodged in the building by Llanelli Rural Council. It is likely that the results of these surveys will not be ready until late October / early November, therefore the date for the Public Meeting to discuss the future of the Centre will not be until early December.
