523. LLYS WESTFA, FELINFOEL – APPLICATION TO PRUNE TWO TREES COVERED BY TREE PRESERVATION ORDER S10

Members were circulated with a letter from the Head of Planning, Carmarthenshire County Council, informing that they had received an application to undertake works on nine trees located on the grounds of 48 Llys Westfa, Felinfoel. The work was necessary for health and safety reasons and involved a crown reduction and removal of ivy.
