# 386. PLANNING APPLICATION DETERMINED UNDER THE CLERK'S DELEGATED POWERS PLANNING APPLICATION S/19615 LAND TO THE NORTH EAST OF GLYNCOED YARD HALFWAY, LLANELLI

Further to Minute No. 176, the Clerk informed Members that amended plans had been received in respect of the above planning application.

In view of there being no significant material change to the original set of plans the Clerk stated that he had reaffirmed the Council's original objection to the planning application namely:

- 1. Environmental concerns over the potential amount of noise and dust pollution likely to be generated by the plant training facility.
- 2. The land served as a buffer zone between the school and the designated employment land and mitigated against any harm created by the resultant machinery noise and dust already generated from the site.

- 3. The field served as an informal recreational area and served as a buffer between built up areas.
- 4. The field and pond were considered important local amenity areas which helped promote biodiversity.
