NO OBJECTION – However the Council wished to place on record that it was concerned over the large increase in traffic volume that would be generated by the development and the detrimental impact this would have on the surrounding road network, especially Denham Avenue, Iscoed and Sandy Road. Furthermore, it was disappointing that the proposed open public space would not be provided on the site of the current pitch as originally proposed in the outline planning consent. The Council was of the opinion that the effect of opening up the Cille stream and transferring the public open space to this section of the site would reduce the amount of useable public amenity space available to the community.
