439. NATIONAL GRID MILFORD HAVEN GAS CONNECTION

Members received correspondence from the Project Manager, Nationalgrid stating that permission had been granted for the construction of the new pipeline between Milford Haven and Aberdulais. No major disruption was envisaged but in the short term there would be an increase in vehicular movement in some of the areas in the community but the residents that would be affected would receive notification.
