84. LLYS WESTFA – FELINFOEL – APPLICATION TO FELL TREES COVERED BY TREE PRESERVATION ORDER S10

Members were circulated with a letter from the Head of Planning, Carmarthenshire County Council informing that he had received an application to undertake works on a Sycamore tree as a result of disease (honey fungus) located in the grounds of 41 Llys Westfa, Felinfoel.

85. PROPOSED WAITING RESTRICTIONS – COUNTY OF CARMARTHENSHIRE

Members were circulated with correspondence from the Head of Administration and Law, Carmarthenshire County Council, informing of the Carmarthenshire County Council's proposal to introduce Proposed Waiting Restrictions at Any Time at Ynys y Cwm Road, and Pentrepoeth Road, Furnace, in accordance with the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996.

RESOLVED that no objection be made to the proposal.

86. TEMPORARY IMPOSITION OF SPEED LIMITS – PEMBERTON, LLANELLI

Members were circulated with correspondence from the Head of Administration and Law, Carmarthenshire County Council, informing of the Carmarthenshire County Council's proposal to introduce a temporary 30 mph Speed Limit at Pemberton, Llanelli, in accordance with the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996.

The restrictions were being introduced in the interests of road safety during the development of the Pemberton site for the proposed new rugby stadium and retail park. The restrictions would come into effect on 3 July, 2006, and would continue in force for 18 months.

RESOLVED that no objection be made to the proposal.

87. TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT (1990) APPEAL APP 607/S/12401 AND APP 608/S/12486 PROPOSED DEVELOPMENTS AT 1 & 1A MYRTLE HILL, PONTHENRI, LLANELLI

Members were circulated with correspondence received from the Head of Planning, Carmarthenshire County Council, stating that appeals had been lodged with the National Assembly for Wales against the decision of the County Council to refuse planning permission for the above developments. The writer stated that the appeals were to be decided on the basis of an exchange of written statements by the parties and a site visit by an Inspector.

RESOLVED that the information be noted.

88. SPEED RESTRICTIONS AT FIVE ROADS

Cllr. T. J. Jones advised Members of the speeding problems at Five Roads. Interactive speed control panels had previously been installed and for the first 6 months proved to be an excellent solution.

Motorists were now paying no attention to the speed restrictions and concern had been raised by the volume of traffic speeding through the village in particular the mornings, alleged to be 49 mph. A petition had been received for 30 mph signs to be erected on lamp posts in the village. Following general discussion, it was

RESOLVED that in the interest of road safety a letter of support be forwarded to the Highways Department, Carmarthenshire County Council requesting that:

- 1. Speed limit signs (30 mph) be erected on every public lighting column along the main road;
- 2. The mobile speed camera unit carry out periodic speed checks in the village; and
- 3. Whether a formal school crossing could be established in the village.
