150. TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990 (AS AMENDED) SECTION 77 – APPLICATION BY LLANELLI RUGBY CLUB SITE: STRADEY PARK AND ADJOINING LAND MAES Y COED, LLANELLI

Further to Minute No. 287 (20 November, 2007), Members were circulated with correspondence from the Decisions Branch, Planning Division, Welsh Assembly Government informing of the Welsh Ministers' decision letter in the above application. The Minister agreed with the Inspector's conclusions to grant planning consent. Accordingly, the Minister granted outline permission in respect of the planning application for up to 450 residential units comprising of 2, 3, and 4 bedroom detached and semi-detached houses, terraced houses and apartments with 0.9 hectare public open space on land at Stradey Park and adjoining land, Maes -y- Coed, Llanelli, but subject to conditions.

During discussion Cllr. M. B. Hughes withdrew from the meeting.

RESOLVED that the information be noted.

151. ENVIRONMENTAL SCOPING REPORT FOR THE PROPOSED REDEVELOPMENT OF THE EXISTING TAYBRITE RECYCLING FACILITY AT BYNEA

Members were circulated with correspondence from the Environmental Consultant, Hyder Consulting (UK) Limited. The writer stated that Hyder had been appointed by Taybrite Recycling Limited to prepare an Environmental Scoping report for the proposed redevelopment of the existing Taybrite recycling facility at Bynea, Llanelli.

Taybrite Recycling Ltd proposed to improve the current facility to modernise and enhance recycling processes. Proposals included site infrastructure improvements and increased operating facilities (within the existing boundary). The object was to develop a plant for total processing, recycling and treatment through to final disposal stage.

During discussion of the item the Chairman referred to email correspondence received from the Chairman of Bynea District Forum, objecting to the proposal. An email was also received from Cllr. M. P. Jones (which was circulated during the meeting) objecting to the proposal.

Following full debate it was

RESOLVED that a letter be sent to Hyder Consulting (UK) Limited objecting to the proposal.

152. PEMBERTON, LLANELLI – PROPOSED TRAFFIC ORDERS

Members were circulated with correspondence from the Head of Administration and Law, Carmarthenshire County Council stating that in accordance with the Local Authorities' Traffic Order (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996, the following Traffic Orders were being proposed for Pemberton, Llanelli:

- Waiting Restriction and Street Parking Places Consolidation (Variation No. 8) Order 2007;
- Pemberton, Llanelli (Clearway) Order 2007;
- Pemberton, Llanelli (Prohibition of Right Turn) Order 2007;
- Pemberton, Llanelli (Prohibition of Driving) Order 2007;
- Pemberton, Llanelli (One-Way Traffic) Order 2007;
- Pemberton, Llanelli (Prohibition of Driving) (Designated Bus Lane) (One-way Working) Order 2007; and
- Pemberton, Llanelli (Imposition of 40MPH Speed Limit) Order 2007.

RESOLVED that no objection be made to the proposals.

Correspondence was received from the Head of Planning Services, Carmarthenshire County Council stating the Carmarthenshire Biodiversity Partnership, led by the Local Record Centre was undertaking a survey of veteran and significant trees in the county.
