Following discussion, during which the Deputy Clerk stated that Members could request full copies of the reports, it was

RESOLVED that the inspection reports be accepted.

293. TRALLWM COMMUNITY HALL

Cllr. S. L. Davies declared a personal and prejudicial interest in the following matter as she was a member of Trallwm Community Hall Management Committee and left the meeting after her introduction. Cllr. T. M. Donoghue declared a personal and prejudicial interest in the following matter as she was a member of Trallwm Community Hall Management Committee and left the meeting before discussion commenced. Cllr. E. Simmons declared a personal and prejudicial interest in the following matter as she was a member of the Trallwm Community Hall Management Committee and left the meeting before discussion commenced.

Cllr. S. L. Davies had raised a concern regarding the hire agreement with the organisations when using Trallwm Community Hall and changing facilities.

The Deputy Clerk informed Members that under the current scheme a 'Terms and Conditions of Use for the Changing Rooms' was in place for Trallwm AFC to use the changing rooms and community hall facilities at Trallwm Community Hall. However, if other users were to use the changing room facilities then this agreement would be withdrawn by the Council and the Bond repaid to Trallwm AFC. The hall management committee would be responsible for drawing up an agreement for the hire of the changing rooms. The hall committee and the changing room hirer would need to check the facilities before and after use and take action if there was a misuse of the facilities.

Following discussion, it was

RESOLVED that the Deputy Clerk contacts the hall management committee to establish if there was more than one hirer of the changing room facilities. If so, then the Council would withdraw the 'Terms and Conditions of Use for the Changing Rooms' and it would be the

responsibility of the hall management committee to issue agreements with the changing room hirers.

Cllr. S. L. Davies re-joined the meeting and chaired the meeting for the remainder of the business to be transacted.

294. TRANSFER OF ASSET DANYBANC PLAY AREA

A request had been received from Cllr. W. V. Thomas to discuss the possible asset transfer of Danybanc Play Area from Carmarthenshire County Council. Cllr. Thomas was unable to attend the meeting to discuss the request in more detail, but instead Cllr. H. J. Evans (local member for Felinfoel) agreed to raise the issue on Cllr. Thomas' behalf.

Following discussion, whereby Members raised concern regarding the condition of the play equipment, it was

RESOLVED that an independent report be commission and reported back to a future meeting of the Recreation and Welfare Committee with an estimated cost for replacing the play equipment and surfacing on a like for like basis.

Arising out of the preceding Minute, it was

FURTHER RESOLVED that a list of capital projects be presented at the next committee meeting to enable Members to prioritise the Capital Scheme Schedule for recommendations to Council.
