The building would provide a space for indoor activities with associated amenities including offices, customer services and first aid. There would be three further structures providing supplementary facilities – a canvas or polycarbonate roof covered area for food and beverages, a single storey building for male, female and fully accessible toilet facilities, a biomass plant room and fuel silo.
