3. Community Facilities – Maintenance Works

Report noted.

4. Footway Lighting – Penygraig to Saron Hall (Genwen footpath)

To help determine whether to support the request from Cllr D. Cundy, information shall be obtained from Carmarthenshire County Council, as to who is responsible for maintaining the existing footway lighting infrastructure and whether any Section 106 funding is available to help with reinstating/repairing the current set of lights along the footpath. Once the information is obtained the matter shall be re-presented to committee but noting that if the council ultimately agreed to support the request there is no budget provision currently available to help fund the work in the current financial year.

5. Felinfoel Recreation Ground – request to erect an advertising hoarding in the grounds

It was agreed to refer the request to Felinfoel Rugby Club for its consideration.

6. Gwendraeth Heritage Trail – Information Boards – financial contribution towards the maintenance of the information boards.

To help determine whether the council is able to offer any financial assistance, further information shall be obtained from Llangyndeyrn Community Council regarding the

location and number of display boards in the council's administrative area and details of who originally supplied and erected the boards. Once the information is obtained the matter shall be re-presented to committee for further consideration.
