## 216. WHITE LION DEPOT – LEASE

Members considered the report of the Technical and General Operations Manager on the proposal to renew the lease for the White Lion Depot, Pemberton.

Members were informed that the current lease was due to expire on 25 March, 2023, and it was desirable to re-new the lease as the site met the council's various needs and given that Officers had been unsuccessful in identifying other cheaper suitable alternative locations.

The landlord was keen to secure his long-term plans for the whole site at Pemberton and had proposed both parties agree to a mutual termination of the existing lease whereby it was immediately replaced with a new agreement based on the following terms:

- 20 year term with 3 x 5 year rent/break and rent/review clauses inserted.
- £6,000 annual rental fixed for the first five years.
- Future rent reviews based on Retail Price Index (RPI), as opposed to the current terms based on speculative market value.
- The existing dilapidated council storage building could be demolished at the council's expense with no obligation to construct a new facility.
- The current annual rental of £4,100 would be uplifted to the new rate commencing from April 2022.
