4. Jubilee Trees – matter requested for inclusion on the agenda by Cllr. S. M. Caiach.

Members considered a suggestion from Cllr. S. M. Caiach to plant a tree in each of the council's seven electoral wards in recognition of the Queen's Jubilee in June 2022.

It was agreed to support Cllr Caiach's suggestion and to accept her tree donation offer, with officers making arrangements to plant the trees in appropriate locations throughout the council's area following council wide consultation with members. The trees would be protected with tree guards until they were established.

5. Felin Fach, Ponthenri – Street Lighting – to consider email correspondence from Public Lighting, Carmarthenshire County Council and to agree the council's response.
