In the summer period the majority of the time focusses on ground maintenance activities, whereas in the winter period the focus switches more to buildings' maintenance activities. Cemetery and Porterage activities are performed throughout the year.

The Council has put in place a preventative maintenance budget based on an annual list of priorities and to cater for day to day contingencies. By adopting a preventative approach this supports sustainable development principles. The cyclical annual maintenance programme ensures community assets are kept in good order, extending the life cycle of the assets over many years.

I am writing to you on behalf of Felinfoel RFC who run Minis, Juniors and Senior rugby teams,

involving over 250 children, parents and 70 Senior players. For the last 30 years we have had floodlights at Felinfoel Recreational Ground which has enabled us to maintain all these rugby teams and provide Rugby for the community of Felinfoel.

After our last survey of the floodlights, it was found that the lights were no longer functioning properly so we have had to isolate them at the Main fuse box and they can no longer be used until work is done on them. Its important for the community of Felinfoel to be able to maintain growth and sustainability for rugby in the village that we have floodlights without them Rugby in Felinfoel would struggle to survive.

Felinfoel RFC are actively seeking grant funding for the floodlights project and are asking Llanelli Rural Council Recreation and Welfare Committee for its support with the grant application and that they agree to allow appointed Contractors by Felinfoel RFC to access the recreation ground and electrical substation to replace the underground cable and also replace the existing lights with LED units on the existing posts which have been inspected and will be coated with appropriate paint to prevent any damage

The underground cable is old and inadequate and new cable, complying with current legislation needs to be installed. The lamps are old halogen bulbs and were expensive to maintain and operate, they will be replaced by modern LED units which will be much more efficient and cost effective. Felinfoel RFC also confirms that all groundwork will be carried out in collaboration with the approved contractors and Llanelli Rural Council Facilities Management Officer. All disturbed ground and excavations will be reinstated to the satisfaction of Llanelli Rural Council Officer .

I enclose a photo of the bench and the required placement


