3. Community Facilities – Maintenance Works.

Report noted.

4. Multi Use Games Area, Heol Gwili, Llwynhendy – Floodlighting Electricity Supply – to receive the report of the Technical and General Services Manager.

(1)The difficulties in securing a timely new energy contract for the MUGA floodlighting electricity supply be noted.

(2)Officers continue to source a new energy contract having due consideration of the potential impact on the council's acceptance and inclusion on the Crown Commercial Services energy framework. Notwithstanding this the MUGA electricity contract shall be pursued as a priority.

(3)A further report shall be presented to committee in relation to the council's inclusion on the Crown Commercial Services framework and the impact of this on the council's various other electricity accounts once the new contract for the MUGA electricity supply had been determined and activated.

(4)In regard to the postponed community football sessions delivered by the Swansea AFC Skills Academy at the Llwynhendy MUGA, that the Dafen MUGA facility be offered to the Academy to use as an interim measure.

5. Air Pollution Sandy Road, Llanelli – matter requested for inclusion on the agenda by Cllr. W. E. Skinner.

Cllr. Skinner informed members of the air pollution issues in the Llanelli area and in particular Sandy Road.

As an initial step it was agreed that officers draft a letter of concern to the Climate Change, Decarbonisation and Sustainability Committee, Carmarthenshire County Council. Moreover, that a meeting of the council's Climate Change Steering Group be convened to discuss what further measures could be pursued with the county council. Alongside this the meeting shall serve as an opportunity to also review progress with the council's adopted and planned measures to tackle the impact of climate change in regard to the council's own actions and activities.

6. Blue Plaque – Saron Community Hall – to consider a request received from a member of Cŵr Mebion Llanelli for a blue plaque to be erected outside Saron Community Hall to commemorate the inception of Cŵr Mebion Llanelli and to agree the Council's response.

Permission to erect a plaque to the exterior of the hall was granted.
