45. MEMBERS' DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

46. **APPOINTMENT OF SUB-COMMITTEE**

47. SCHEDULES OF PAYMENTS

52. TRAINING FACILITY – FOOTHOLD ENTERPRISE VILLAGE BURY ROAD, LLANELLI

The Technical and General Operations Manager informed members that officers were still trying to source accommodation for the Prince's Trust programme and would receive more information towards the end of the week for another possible premises in Felinfoel.
