#### 3. LONG TERM IMPLICATIONS

3.1 The work programme is organised on a cyclical basis covering the summer and winter periods. In the summer period the majority of the time focusses on ground maintenance activities, whereas in the winter period the focus switches more to buildings' maintenance activities. Cemetery and Porterage activities are performed throughout the year.

The Council has put in place a preventative maintenance budget based on an annual list of priorities and to cater for day to day contingencies. By adopting a preventative approach this

priorities and to cater for day to day contingencies. By adopting a preventative approach this supports sustainable development principles. The cyclical annual maintenance programme ensures community assets are kept in good order, extending the life cycle of the assets over many years.
