MEETING NOTES

At a Recreation and Welfare Committee Meeting hosted at the Council Chamber, Vauxhall Buildings, Vauxhall, Llanelli and via remote attendance on Tuesday, 17 September, 2024, at 4.45 p.m.

3. Community Facilities – Maintenance Works.

Report noted.

4. Safer Routes in the Communities – Five Roads Recreation Ground – Creation of New Pathway – matter requested for inclusion on the agenda by Cllr. A. Evans requesting that the council takes on the responsibility and the maintenance for the pathway once constructed.

Permission be granted in principle for the work to commence at Five Roads Recreation Ground for the creation of a new pathway subject to receiving a plan of the proposed route. Once the work had been completed, the council would take on the responsibility for the maintenance of the pathway, including meeting the cost of energy charges associated with public lighting, if it is decided to install footway lighting columns along the route of the pathway, as part of the scheme.

5. Furnace Community Hall - Hall Management Committee – further to Minute No. 91(2), to receive information from local ward members on plans to convene an extraordinary general meeting at Furnace Community Hall to establish a new management committee.

The local ward member informed the committee that a public meeting was to be convened on 2 October, 2024, at Furnace Community Hall. Social media had been used to help promote the event along with posters being displayed in various community locations. In addition to this over 300 leaflets had been hand delivered to properties in the immediate area.
