I'd be happy to provide any information you need!

The Llanelli LGBTQ+ Support Group has been running for many years earlier, but formalised our constitution in 2019. We've provided a safe space for members of the LGBTQ+ to share their woes, get to know other members of the community, and socialise. We primarily attract a 55+ crowd who are clearly lonely, and looking for friends who are on the same wavelength and are safe to be open with. We also organise events in accordance with what our users like to do, for instance, last year we organised a group visit to St Fagan's Museum for a tour of the LGBTQ+ historical archive in the museum, which was very well received. We're regularly gathering feedback from our regulars for future events. In fact, this coming Tuesday we're attending a performance of the Rocky Horror Picture show.

We were initially based in Marsh Street, but last year we've moved our office to 154 Station Road.

Ongoing funding to keep these activities going often proves a challenge, as we're a not for profit social enterprise, and we're exploring options for continuity.
