The Llanelli-Agen Rugby Exchange June 2026

The Llanelli-Agen Rugby Exchange is an exciting initiative that began in June 2025, aimed at promoting youth schoolboy rugby and strengthening ties between communities. The inaugural exchange, played in Agen saw Llanelli winning, setting a strong foundation for future competitions. The programme continues with a reciprocal visit planned for June 2026, where the next match will be held at Ffwrnes Rugby Club on Saturday, 20th June. Ahead of the game, a mayoral reception will take place on Friday, 19th June, hosted by Mayor Cllr Roberts, highlighting the cultural and community significance of this growing rugby partnership.

The Agen group of 31 will be flying into Bristol on the morning of Friday the 19th. With the support of the Scarlets, a stadium tour has been arranged on the afternoon of the 19th and the use of the training barn at Parc Scarlets has been confirmed for both teams to train on the Friday evening. They will be staying in Y Doc (bunk accommodation) at North Dock and will return to Agen on the evening of the 21st June.

However, funding for the visit has proven challenging. The Llanelli and District Twinning Association has been working hard to support the exchange, launching a sponsorship pack to attract financial backing from businesses (attending the Chamber of Trade in February) and the wider community. We also held a successful fundraiser in March, with a further event planned for May/June, as efforts continue to ensure the visit can go ahead and provide valuable opportunities for the young players involved.

The young players in the Llanelli Team are from all over Llanelli, both from the Town and Rural Council areas.

We would very much like to have a discussion with you and your team to see how the Llanelli Rural Council could be involved and also look to see if you would be able to look at sponsorship/grant support for the exchange.

It goes without saying, that we will extend a formal invitation to the Chair of LRC to the match and hope that your elected members and families would like to come and support the team.

REF: INTRODUCTION TO THE LLANELLI COMMUNITY FRIDGE

I'm writing to introduce you to the Llanelli Community Fridge, a project based on Station Road, Llanelli which provides free access to good quality surplus food for anyone who needs support. Although this may be the first time you've heard about our work, the project has become a significant resource for both Llanelli Town and Rural areas.

Last year alone, we supported more than 9,000 people, with individuals and families. In addition to local residents, people from Pontiets, Llwynhendy, Five Roads, and Dafen as well as further away used the service. Most notably this year, demand remains high, and we have already supported 3,500 people.

The Community Fridge is open Wednesday to Friday, from 12pm to 4pm, and is stocked through regular donations from supermarkets, local businesses, and individual residents. Our shelves typically include fresh fruit and vegetables, tinned goods, household essentials, books, and other useful items. Everything is freely available, with no referral process or eligibility criteria. We are also part of HUBBUB's national Community Fridge network, which promotes food redistribution and reduces waste across the UK.

In addition to the fridge itself, we provide one-day emergency food parcels and offer digital support to people facing urgent or complex challenges. For many households, the fridge has become a trusted and accessible point of support during difficult times.

I'm reaching out to ask whether the Council might consider contributing towards the running costs of this service. While our volunteers remain committed to collecting, sorting, and distributing food, essential costs such as utilities, equipment maintenance, and community outreach continue to rise. Any support you can offer would directly strengthen and sustain this lifeline for local residents.

Any surpluses that the company makes will be ploughed back into the aims of the company.

Hi Mark,

Thanks for the quick response, I must be lucky on the timing!

We ask everyone that uses the community fridge to provide their post code, how many people live in their house and any comments on each visit. This helps us to work out the stats.

Along side local residents from Tyisha, Seaside and general town area we have families attending from Pwll, Five Roads, Ponthenri, Dafen, Llwynhendy, Bynea and Felinfoel. We have had some people attend from as far as Ammanford as well.

Whilst the community fridge is about tackling food waste, it has been vital for families on low income as well as those working and still unable to pay the bills.

We collect food from KFC Cross Hands, Nandos Llanelli, Lidl Llanelli and businesses from around the area sometimes donate their surplus.

Theres no charge for access to the community fridge but donations are welcome. Volunteers from around the Llanelli area give up their time to collect the food for us.

Even though it's a community fridge, it's not just food. We provide free books, baby items, clothing, and bric a brac. We work with organisations to provide coats, hand out winter warmer items and sometimes 1 day emergency food parcels.

If theres anything i've missed from your questions, please let me know and I would be more than happy to answer in more detail.

With your continued support, we can ensure that this unique festival continues to thrive, celebrating Welsh culture, welcoming visitors from around the world, and creating lasting cultural, social and economic benefits for the region.
